- Confused.

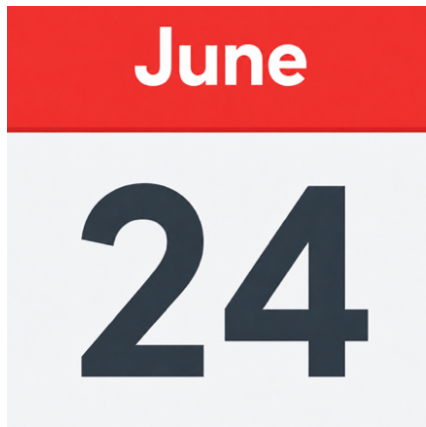


The Disability Dialogue wants to create a safe space to talk about changes that may happen to the NDIS.
